So, What IS Square Dancing?

Square Dancing is a form of folk dance combining a series of “called” movements strung together to make up a dance. Each of these movements is taught by your instructor and can be put together in millions of ways. Plus, you learn the dance moves with seven other people in a square at the same time.

Square Dancers are All “Old”

Yes—square dancers are predominately older people. Let’s face it—anyone over 30 is considered old!

Do I Have to Wear the Funny Clothes?
